Crater Lake Soda moves to stores

Crater Lake Soda is moving from the taps to bottles with a new line of specialty sodas to be distributed in Pacific Northwest grocery stores this summer.

Root beer, orange cream, lemon lime bitter and vanilla cream sodas, brewed and bottled in Portland and distributed by **Ocean Mist Sales & Marketing**, are made with pure cane sugar without additives such as caffeine or foam enhancers.

Crater Lake Soda, which has been the premium root beer on tap at most McMenemy's restaurants in Oregon and Washington for several years, will be available in numerous Portland grocery stores, including Lamb's Thriftway, Bale's Thriftway, Roth's and Zupan's markets. Crater Lake Sodas will be available in individual 12 oz. bottles, six-packs, cases of 24, and will continue to remain available in kegs.
